

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-01

ORDINANCE TO CREATE CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE II, SECTION 6.113 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING "CLASS A" LIQUOR LICENSE RESTRICTION ON TIME OF SALES

WHEREAS, 2011 Wisconsin Act 97 amended the state law regarding the sale times for certain alcohol beverage retailers to read "No premises for which a "Class A" license or permit has been issued may remain open for the sale of intoxicating liquor between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m." (Wis. Stats. Section 125.68 (4) (b)); and

WHEREAS, prior to the change in the aforementioned statute, the restriction on the probation of sales of intoxicating liquor permitted under a "Class A" license was between the hours of 9 p.m. and 8 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, 2011 Wisconsin Act 97 allows for local municipalities, by local ordinance, to impose more restrictive hours than the aforementioned statute.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Pewaukee, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE:**DIVISION 2. "CLASS A" LIQUOR LICENSE**

Section 6.113 is being created as follows:

Section 6.113. Time of Sales Limited.

No premises for which a "Class A" license or permit has been issued may remain open for the sale of intoxicating liquor between the hours of 9 p.m. and 8 a.m.

SECTION TWO: All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

SECTION THREE: The several sections of this ordinance shall be considered severable. If any section shall be considered by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of other portions of the ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.


